

# Student Success Seminar

The Bakersfield College Counseling Department has changed its "At-Risk" policy for students below a 2.0 grade point average or who have completed less than half of units enrolled in overall. Students are now required to adhere to a 2-step or 3-step process.

## **All probation status students must complete Step 1.**

Step 1: Complete Student Success

## **Probation 2 status and Disqualified students must also complete Step 2.**

Step 2: Face-to-Face Workshop

- Students on Probation and/or Progress Probation 1 do not need to attend the workshop in Counseling.

## **Probation 2 and Disqualified students must also complete Step 3.**
