

HOW TO CALCULATE YOUR GPA

4 POINT SYSTEM

- ⦿ A = 4 points
 - ⦿ B = 3 points
 - ⦿ C = 2 points
 - ⦿ D = 1 point
 - ⦿ F = 0 points
-
- ⦿ Example: Hist B17a grade of A will receive 4 points for each unit of A. Hist B17a is a 3 unit class.
$$3 \text{ units} \times 4 \text{ points} = 12 \text{ grade points}$$

⊙ Hist B17a	3	A (x4)	12
⊙ Engl B1a	4	C (x2)	8
⊙ Math BA	5	D (x1)	5

⊙ STDV B1	<u>0.5</u>	<u>A (x4)</u>	<u>2</u>

33 grade points = 2.0 GPA
 16.5 units

BANNER UNITS

- There are 4 kinds of units on MyBanWeb:
 - Attempted hours
 - Passed hours
 - Earned hours
 - GPA hours
- Important:
 - Use GPA hours located in MyBanWeb when calculating your cumulative GPA.
 - Units attempted which result in CR/NC, W, IP, or I grades are not used in computing GPA

QUALITY POINTS GPA HOURS

$$= \text{GPA}$$



	Attempted Hours	Passed Hours	Earned Hours	GPA Hours	Quality Points	GPA
Institution:	43.500	9.000	9.000	12.500	30.00	2.40
Transfer:	.000	.000	.000	.000	.00	.00
Overall:	43.500	9.000	9.000	12.500	30.00	2.40

$$\frac{30 \text{ quality points}}{12.5 \text{ GPA hours}} = 2.40 \text{ GPA}$$

GPA DEFICIENT EXAMPLE

Course	Units	Grade & Point Value	Total Grade Points
⊙ Hist B17a	3	A (x4)	12
⊙ Engl B1a	4	D (x1)	4
⊙ Math BA	5	D (x1)	5
⊙ PHED B6fcx	1	B (x3)	3
⊙ Art B3ab	3	D (x1)	3
⊙ STDV B1	<u>0.5</u>	<u>A (x4)</u>	<u>2</u>
	16.5		29

29 grade points = 1.75 GPA
 16.5 units

CALCULATING DEFICIENCY

- ◉ If a GPA is less than 2.0 (C average), the student is on academic probation 1.75 GPA
- ◉ To determine grade point deficit:
 - Multiply 2 and the units **attempted** (16.5)
 - Subtract total grade points earned (29)

$$\text{Multiply } 2 \times 16.5 = 33$$

$$\begin{array}{r} - 29 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

4 grade point deficit

The student will need 4 units of B or higher to get off academic probation

HOW TO CHANGE SEMESTER UNITS TO QUARTER UNITS

◉ Semester to Quarter

- Multiple semester units by $3/2$ or 1.5

- Examples:

- $3/2 \times 12$ semester units = 18 quarter units
or
- 1.5×12 semester units = 18 quarter units

◉ Quarter to Semester

- Multiple quarter units by $2/3$ or .667

- Examples:

- $2/3 \times 15$ quarter units = 10 semester units
or
- $.667 \times 15$ quarter units = 10 semester units
